The household count in this area has changed from 5,706 in 2020 to 5,693 in the current year, a change of -0.07% annually. The five-year projection of households is 5,680, a change of -0.05% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.43, compared to 2.42 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 3,680 in the specified area.

## Socioeconomic Status Index

Currently, 63.0% of the 6,308 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 27.3%, renter occupied; and 9.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 6,301 housing units in the area and 9.4% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.03%. Median home value in the area is \$177,121, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.68% annually to \$192,547.

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
